Ground wires on electric poles were stolen, 24 copper crimps and 100 feet of #6 ground wire. Randy wants indicator lights coming in on DP & L lines to tell whether it is their problem or ours on power outages.

Everyone will be using a percentage of solar power. This is more expensive but will only be about 2% or so.
